Intake is continuous and each program is individualized, allowing you to learn at your own pace in a classroom setting one on one or through distance education. “Our staff is able to help people at all levels attain workplace-related essential skills, including

communication, numeracy and technology,” Saint-Cyr says.

Some students can attend class for five hours a day, five days a week, while others can attend just a few hours a day every other day. “We accommodate every learner’s needs as best as we can so they can progress and as quickly as they can,” Saint-Cyr says.

Alpha-Toronto has limited funding to support learners who aren’t on social assistance but have basic needs like a transit pass or a refurbished laptop. “In the end, it’s all about giving them an opportunity to get a job and keep that job,” says Saint-Cyr.
